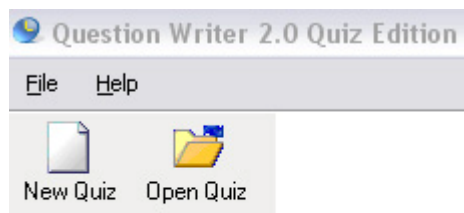

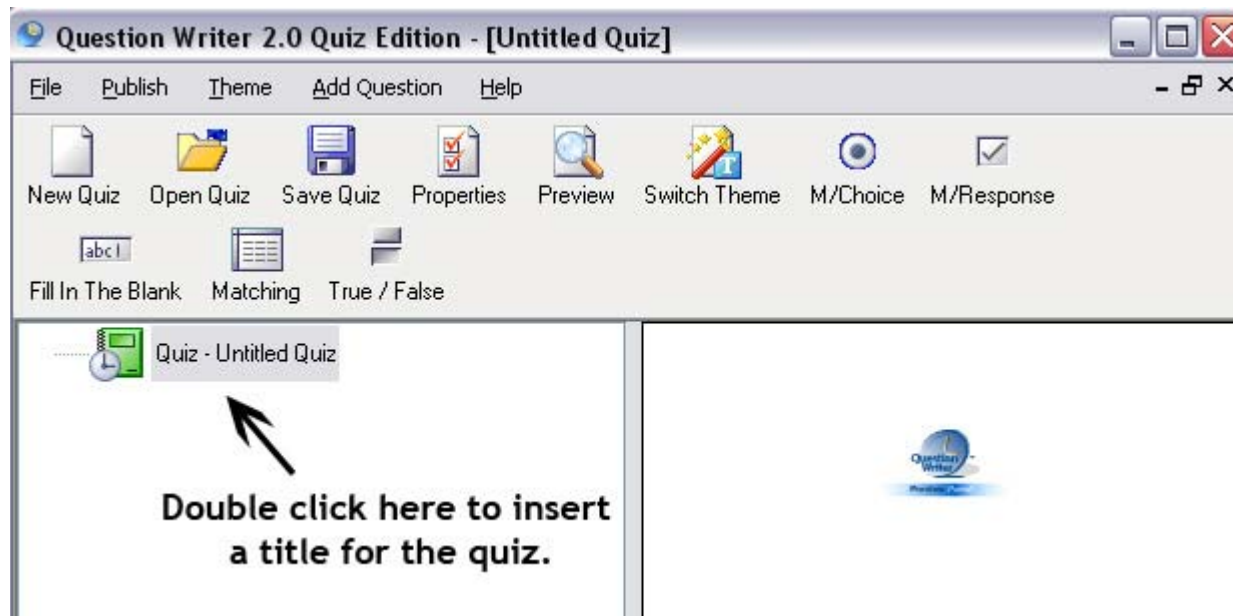
Question Writer Quiz Edition is an easy-to-use editor for creating interactive quizzes. Some of the question formats include multiple-choice, true-false, matching, multiple format and fill-in-the-blank. The pictures below the quiz on this page describe the steps in creating a quiz. The final quiz output will be a SWF Flash file to insert on a web page or into a learning management system such as Scorm.

To create a new quiz, click on the **New Quiz** icon.




**Click 'New Quiz' to
create a quiz.**

Double click the **Quiz-Untitled Quiz** button and type the title of the quiz.




The author can choose to have students sign in using a name or user identification.

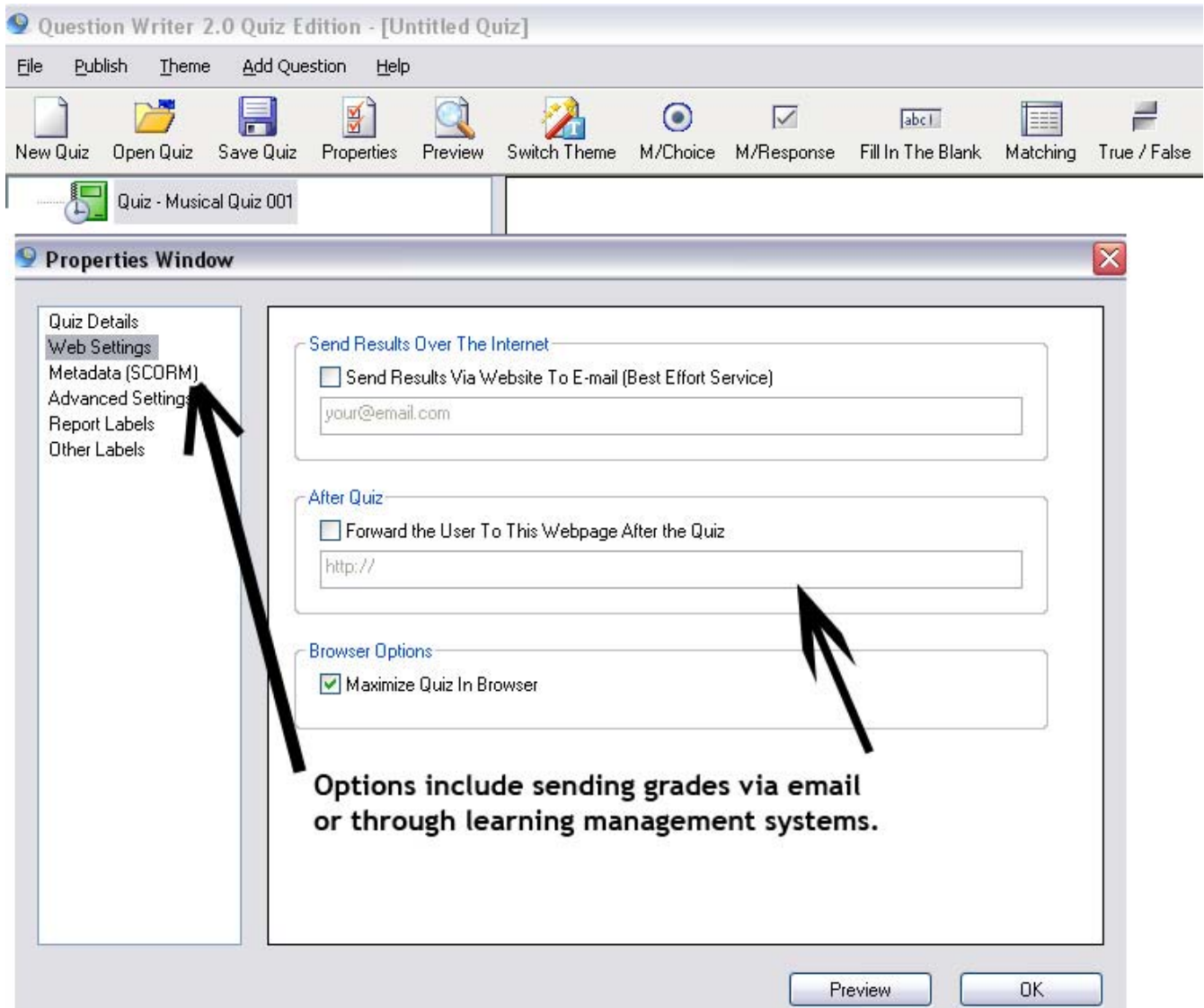
If you select the **Properties** icon, you will find settings for points credited per question, quiz instructions, quiz feedback, randomizing questions and even a time limit for taking the quiz.



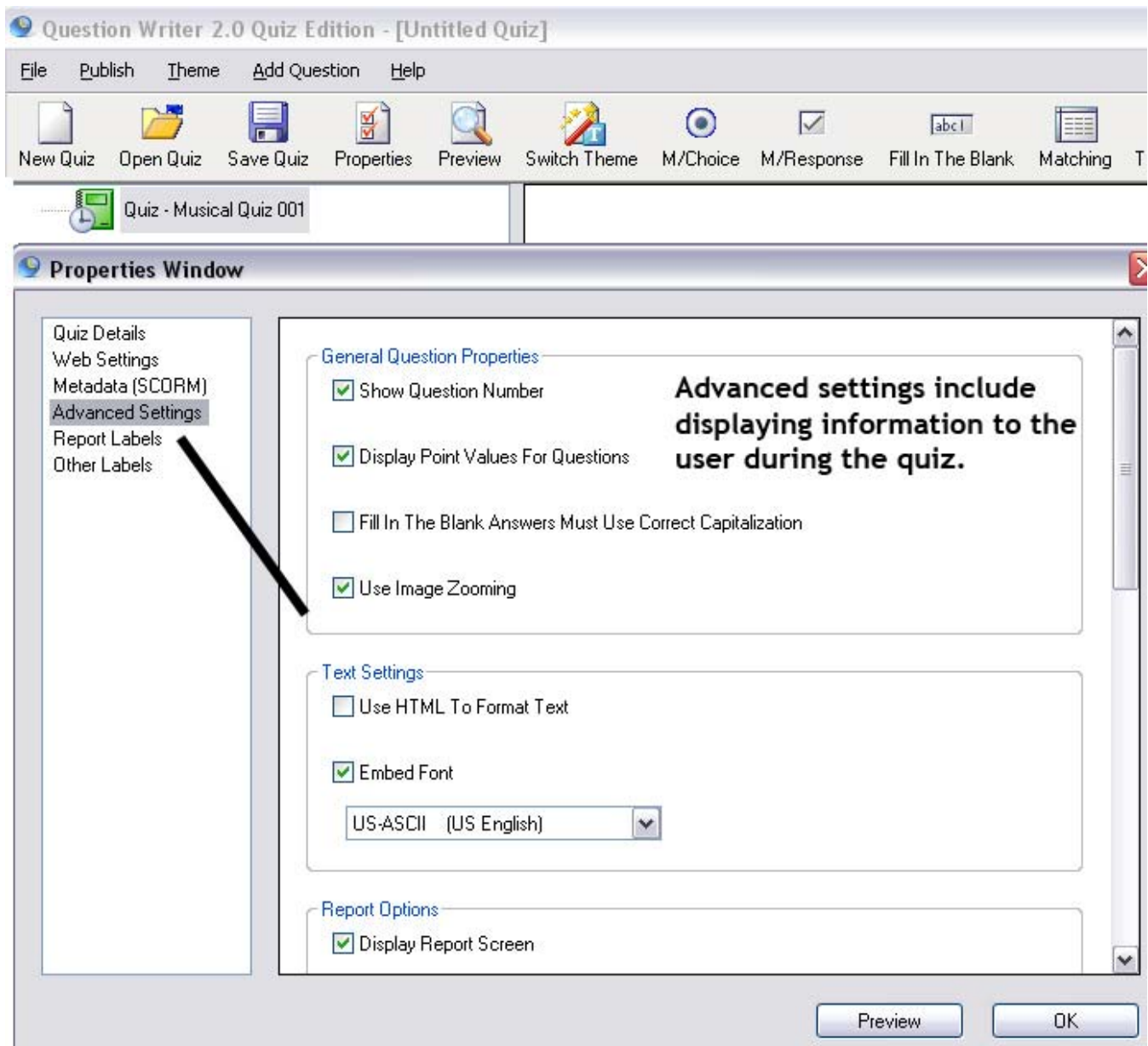

The Properties window has settings for points per question, instructions, feedback and other features to instruct the user about procedures for the quiz.

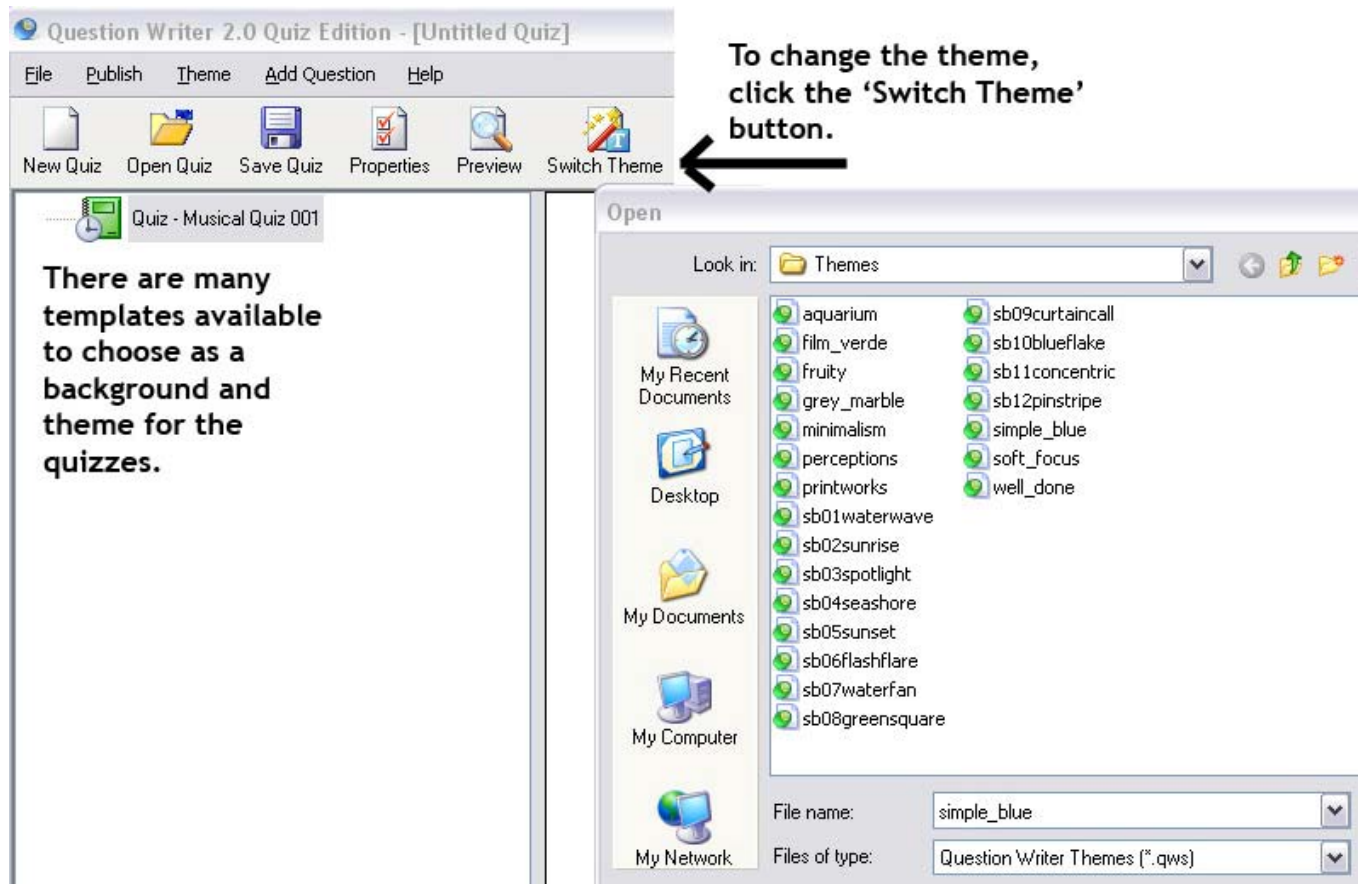
In the **Properties** window, there are also settings for reporting quiz scores through email or Scorm - learning management systems.



Other settings in the **Properties** window include displaying information to the user during the quiz, such as image zooming, point values, and report screen information.



The author can select from many different templates or themes with various backgrounds and fonts to use in the quiz. To change the theme, click the **Switch Theme** button.



Select **Add Question** or the **M/Choice** icon. Enter the text for the question in the **Properties Window** box. Enter the choices in the **Option Text** boxes. Place a check mark by the correct answer. Press **OK**.

It is easy to add an image to the question. Check the **Include Image** box. Select **Add Files** and browse to the location of the .JPG or .GIF image on the computer. Select **Apply** and the picture will be added to the question.

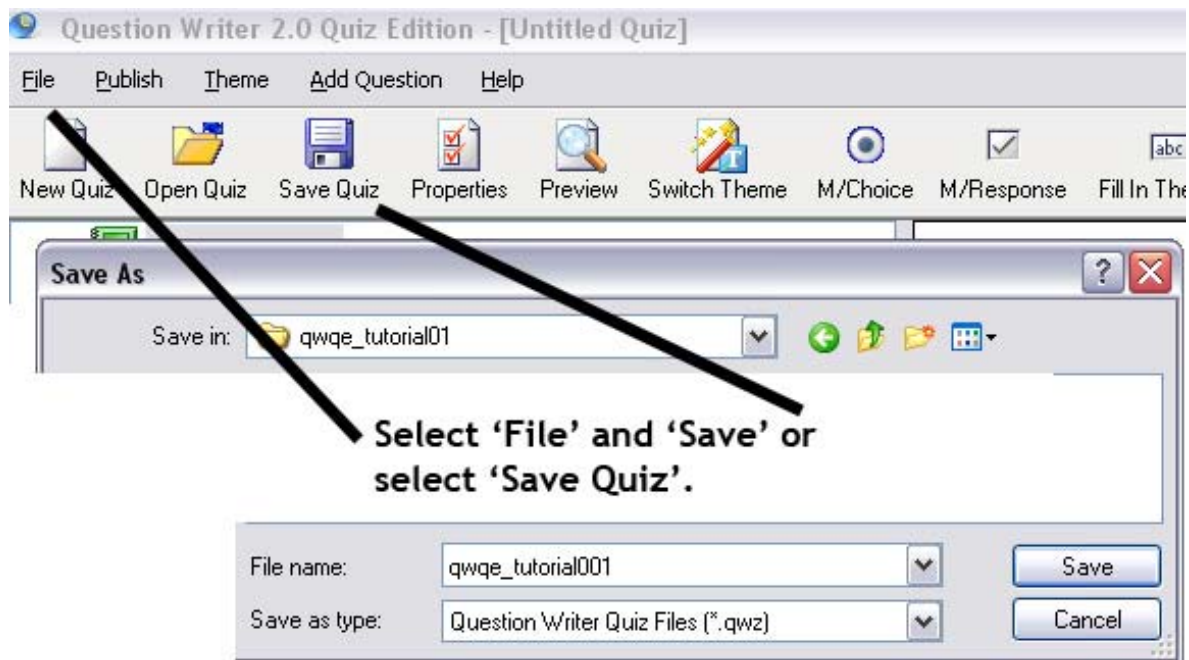

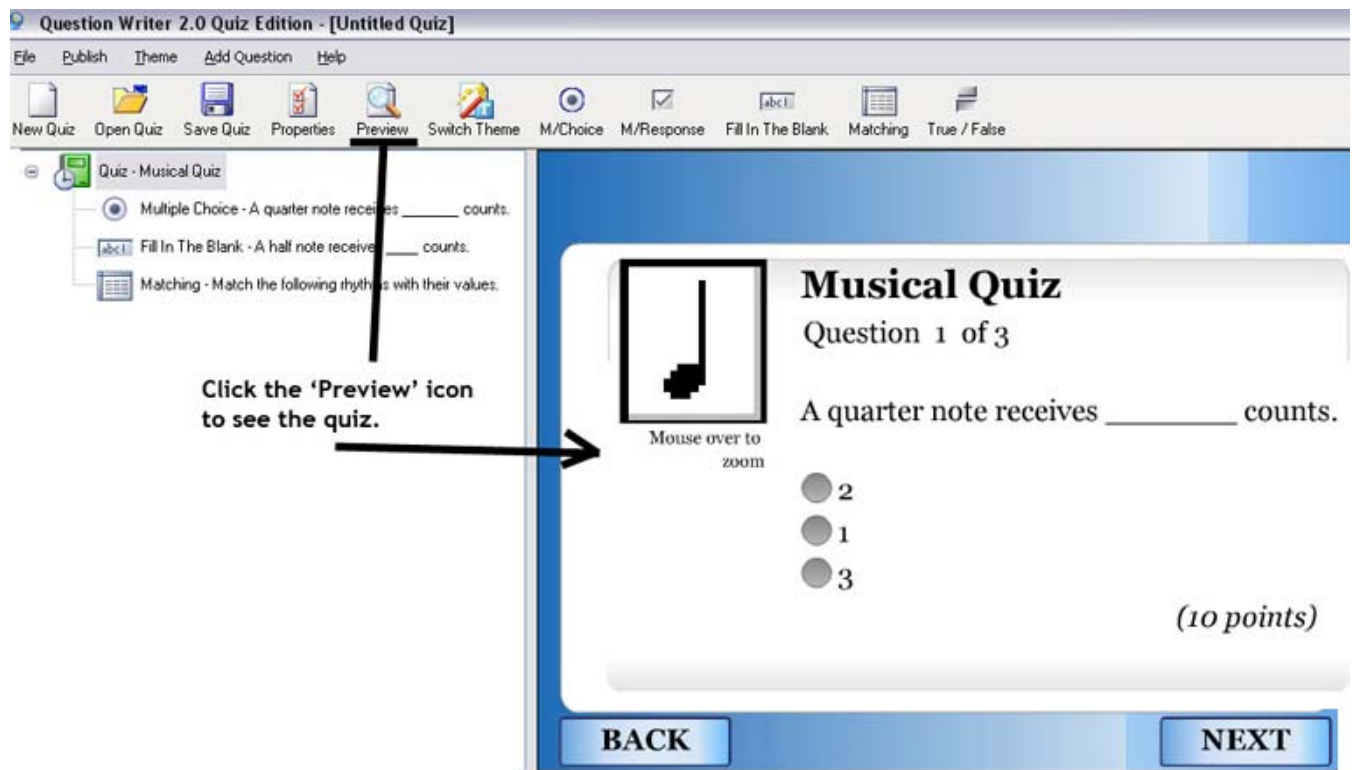


